Student Feedback Analysis (2017-18)

1. Rating course on the following points
 - a. 41.6% (20) students rate this *course extremely good* for Teaching and learning skills, 24.96 % (12) think that course was *very good*, 16.64% (8) feel that it was *Moderately good*, 12.48 % (6) students said that this course was *good* & 4.16% (2) students feel that course was *moderate* for development of Teaching and Learning skills. Most of students were gave positive response for *Teaching and Learning skills*.
 - b. About course Applicability to real life situation, 31.2% (15) students rate this course *extremely good*, 37.44 % (18) think that course was *very good*, 18.72% (9) feel that it was *moderately good*, 12.48 % (6) students said that this course was *good*. Most of students gave positive response for course Applicability to real life situation.
 - c. About Depth of course content 41.6% (20) students rated this course *extremely good*, 22.88% (11) think that course was *very good*, 16.64 % (8) feel that it was *Moderately good*, 14.56 % (7) students said that this course was *good*, 4.16 % (2) students said that Depth of this course was *moderate*.
 - d. Most of students were satisfied about Extent of coverage of course. 68.64% (33) rate it *extremely good*, 20.8 % (10) think that it *very good*, and 10.4 % (5) feel that it was *moderately good*.
 - e. About 62.2% (30) students were agree to Extent of effort required by student rated this course *extremely good*, 16.64% (8) students think that course was *very good*, 12.48% (6) feel that it was *Moderately good*, 8.32 % (4) students said that this course was *good*. Most of students were agree that student's efforts are very important to complete this course.
 - f. 41.6 % (20) students said that Relevance/ learning values of projects / reports was *extremely good*, 20.8% (10) students said that it was *very good*, 14.56% (7)



students said that it was *Moderately good*, 8.32%(4) students said that it was *good*, 14.56% (7) students said that it was *Moderate*.

- g. Overall opinion of student about this course was very positive. 68.69% (33) students rate this course as *Extremely good*, 20.8% (10) students rate this course as *Very good*, 10.40% (5) students said that this course as *Moderately good*.
2. 52 % (25) students said that syllabus of B. Ed course was *Challenging*, 36.36(17) % said that syllabus was *Adequate*, 12.48 %(6) students said that it was *Dull*.
 3. 24.96% (12) students said that their background was *highly relevant* for this course, 41.6% (20) % students said it was *Partly Relevant*, 24.96% (12) students said that it was *Relevant* to their background, and 8.32 % (4) student said that it was *Mostly irrelevant* to their back ground.
 4. 87.5% (42) student said that 90 to 100% syllabus was completed, while 12.48 %(6) students said that 75 to 90% syllabus was completed in the class.
 5. 66.56% (32) students said that library holdings for this course were *Excellent*, while 20.8% (10) said it was *Adequate* and 12.48% (6) said it was *Inadequate*. Over all most of student were happy and satisfied with library holdings.
 6. 60.32% (29) students said that they could get prescribed learning material easily, they rate as *Excellent*, while 31.2% (15) students rated it as *Adequate* and 8.32% (4) said it was *Inadequate*, no any student said that it was poor. Over all most of students was satisfied availability of prescribed readings.
 7. Internal evaluation is important part of the course 83.20% (40) student said that internal evaluation system was *Excellent*, 8.32% (4) students said it was *Adequate* 8.32% (4) said it was *inadequate* and 0% said it was *Poor*.
 8. 10.4% (5) students said that weightage of internal assessment should be given *100%*, while 31.25% (15) student said it should be *75%*, 41.6% (20) said it should be *50%*, 16.64% (8) said it should be *25%*. Overall most of student wants to increase the weightage of internal assessment.
 9. Internal assessment system is integral part of present evaluation system.
 - I. 52% (25) students said that this course was highly easy to understand. 31.2% (15) students said it was *appreciably useful*, 16.64% (8) said students said that it was *moderately conducive*.
 - II. 31.2% (15) students said that this system was highly helpful to understand early discovery of difficulties, while 60.32% (29) students said it was *appreciably*



- useful* & 8.32% (4) students said that *moderately helpful* to find out *early discovery of difficulties*.
- III. 41.6% (20) students found present internal system *highly useful in regular work*, while 49.92 % (24) said it was *appreciably useful* 7.14% (4) said that it was *moderately usefully in regular work*.
- IV. 62.4% (30) students said that internal system was highly useful in interaction with teacher, 27.04% (13) said that it was appreciably useful in interaction with teacher and 10.4% (5) students said that it was moderately conducive in interaction with teacher.
- V. 41.6% (20) students said that this system was highly helpful to in continuous self-assessment; while 49.92% (24) students said it was appreciably useful, 8.32% (4) students said that it was moderately conducive, helpful in continuous self-assessment.
10. 68.64% (33) students said that internal assessment system work fairly in 75 % courses, 30.94 % (15) students said that internal assessment system work unfairly in 25% courses.
11. 74.88% (36) students rated this college as superior in comparison to other teacher training college and 25.12 % (12) student think that this college is equal as other.
12. Overall student teacher relation is very important. 72.85% (35) students thought that their relationship with all teachers was very good, 20.8 % (10) said it was good, 6.24% (3) said it was *satisfactory*.
13. Student's relation with their method teacher is also important. 87.36% (42) students thought that their relationship with their method teacher was *Very good*, 8.32% (4) said it was *good* 4.16% (2) students said it was *satisfactory*.
14. Administrative office must be helpful and respond quickly. 45.76% (22) students found office was *very helpful*, 33.28 % (16) students said office was *helpful* and 20.8 % (10) students said it was *indifferent*.
15. 79.04 % (38) students said that hostel facilities was *very good*, 20.8% (10) students said that it was *good*.
16. 72.8% (35) students said that travelling facilities was *very good*, 10.4% (5) students said that it was *good* and 16.64% (8) student said travelling facilities were *satisfactory*.



17. 31.2 % (15) student said that they have participated *very often* in extracurricular activities, while 31.2% (15) student said *often*, 37.44% (18) said *sometime participated in extracurricular activities*.
18. 87.36% (42) student said that attitude of teacher towards extracurricular activities was *co-operative*, 12.48% (6) said it was *indifferent*.
19. 74.88% (36) students said that time at the college was *useful* for intellectually enriching, 24.96% (12) said it was *marginally useful*.
20. After leaving this college 79.04 % (38) student said that they will talk *proudly* about this college, 20.8% (10) said that *indifferently* talk about this college.
21. Overall rating given by students to B.Ed program was as follows.
- I. Academic content of this program- 20.8% (10) student said it was very good, 46.76% (22) said it was good and 31.2% (15) said it was average, 2.08% (1) student said that content was poor.
 - II. Fairness of evaluation of this program- 16.64% (8) students said it was *very good*, 64.48% (31) student said it was *good* and 18.72 % (9) students said it was *average*.
 - III. Interaction with faculty 64.48% (31) students said it was *very good*, 20.8% (10) students said it was *good*, 14.56 % (7) students said it was *average*.
 - IV. Interaction with administration- 41.6% (20) students said it was *very good*, 54.8% (26) students said it was *good*, 4.16% (2) students said it was *average*.
 - V. Library Facilities- 72.8% (35) students was happy with library facilities they rated it as very good, 20.8% (10) students rated it as good. 6.24% (3) students said it was average.
 - VI. Computer Facilities 72.8% (35) students was happy with computer facilities, they have rated it as very good, 16.64 % (8) students rated it as good, 10.4% (5) students said it was average.
 - VII. Hostel Facilities 79.04% (38) students was happy with hostel facilities they rated it as very good, 16.64% (8) students rated it as good, 4.16% (2) students said it was average.
 - VIII. Recreational facilities- 39.52% (19) students said these facilities were very good, 52% (25) students said it was good and 8.32 % (4) said it was average.
 - IX. Extra-curricular activities- 66.56% (32) students said these activities were very good, 16.64% (8) students said it was good and 16.64% (8) said it was an average.



X. Sports facilities- 83.2% (40) students were happy with sports facilities, they rated it as *very good*. 12.48% (6) students said it was *good* and 4.16% (2) said it was *average*.
